*Have you ever noticed that when you change colours when ribbing stitches the little purl stitches poke through on the right side making it look...well kind of messy and not crisp and clean?*



*When you add a new colour just knit the whole row with the new colour and then continue on with your ribbing. Now it's nice and clean and crisp.*
